Completing this form and returning it to the Chief Officer of Unlock is the first step in negotiating for an **Unlock local partnership** for your area. Do not worry if you can't complete every section. Some pieces will fall into place more easily than others. Completing the sections you can, will help us to identify what further work is needed.

Though the local contexts and details will vary there are common criteria and approaches, which define this type of development for Unlock. For each **Unlock Local Partnership** four distinct elements need to come together in a way that makes sense. These are:-

- Locality
- Funding
- Unlock Local Team
- Development Worker

In different locations these elements may emerge in a different order but all will need to be established for an **Unlock Local Partnership** to go ahead.

Local individuals, or groups, who believe that they may have the potential to pull these elements together are known as '*Sponsors*'. Where the *Sponsors* are a group, rather than an individual, it will be helpful for them to appoint a single spokesperson for this process.
