Location. Broadwater Farm Estate. Gloucester Road, North end, West side (opposite Church on the Farm).
Question. How many residential floors are there in the Kenley high rise block?
Answer. 18

L. Plaque on South East side of the memorial garden.
Q. Over what two days did the Broadwater Farm riots take place?
A. 5th & 6th October, 1985.

L. Just inside entrance to Lordship Recreation Ground from Higham Road.
Q. What activity is said to burn off 190 calories?
A. 30 minutes brisk walking.

L. Display panel, North West corner of our route through Lordship Recreation Ground.
Q. When was the Model Traffic Area first opened?
A. 1938

L. Display panel, midway along North-South path in Lordship Recreation Ground, East side.
Q. How many different kinds of birds are depicted here?
A. 14

L. Memorial stone adjacent to 5a, a little bit to the South.
Q. What was the (correct) date of the Downhills Air Raid Shelter disaster?
A. 19th September 1940

L. Display panel at South end of North-South path in Lordship Recreation Ground, East side, just inside gate.
Q. About how many people were in the Downhills Air Raid Shelter at the time of the disaster?
A. 300

L. Display panel at South end of North-South path in Lordship Recreation Ground, East side, just inside gate.
Q. How many different species of tree leaf are pictured here?
A. 12

L. South end of Downhills Park, East side, just inside gate.
Q. Name the 3 famous black residents of Tottenham depicted in this sculpture.
A. Nicola Adams, Walter Tull, Luke Howard.

L. West Green Road, North side, opposite Kirkton Road.
Q. What is the make of the brass and copper coffee machine?
A. (*Clue: Greek princess*) Elektra

L. Markfield Road, East side, about 25% of the way down to the Park entrance.
Q. What colourful logo is used by EuroArts?
A. (*Clue: Look far from road*) A butterfly

L. Display board, Markfield Park, to the West of the Beam Engine House.
Q. In 1865 how many were said to have died as a result of Tottenham's polluted water?
A. 4000
- 11**
L. Retail Park, corner of Broad Lane and Ferry Lane.
Q. How many retail outlets are advertised as being on this retail park?
A. 20, plus one vacant.
- 12**
L. Plaque on front of Tottenham Town Hall (west of Tottenham Green).
Q. What age was Bernie Grant when he died?
A. About 56.
- 13**
L. Tottenham High Road, East side, a little way south of opposite Philip Lane.
Q. What was John Williams' job when he wasn't being a missionary?
A. Shipbuilder.
- 14**
L. Tottenham High Road, West side, opposite Tottenham High Cross.
Q. What is Amazing Grace's motto (exactly)?
A. "God's promise never fail"
- 15**
L. Tottenham High Road, East side, corner of police station at Chesnut Road.
Q. What was the name of PC 403, killed in the Tottenham Outrage in 1909?
A. William Frederick Tyler.
- 16**
L. Unlock Checkpoint, St Mark's Methodist.
Q. Which workers are new to Unlock since last year's walk?
A. Lynette (Hastings) & Adam North (Birmingham)
- 17**
L. On blue plaque near South end of Bruce Grove, South West side.
Q. This chemist and meteorologist invented a naming system for clouds.
A. Luke Howard.
- 18**
L. On building at junction of Lordship Lane with High Road, North East corner.
Q. When was the London Cooperative Society Department Store built?
A. 1930
- 19**
L. Tottenham High Road, East side, opposite Cedar Road.
Q. Why can't you tell the time at the former Whitbread Brewery?
A. The clock faces have no hands.
- 20**
L. Bruce Castle Park, South of museum at gate.
Q. How much does it cost to visit Bruce Castle Museum?
A. It's free.
- 21 (bonus)**
L. Bruce Castle Park, close to North wall of Bruce Castle Museum.
