Location. Lewisham Hospital, south side of walking route, near bridge over stream.
Question. What building houses the Orange Zone?
Answer. Riverside.
- 2**
L. North gate of Ladywell Fields, between gate and railway line.
Q. What does “Quercus” stand for?
A. Quality Urban Environment for River Corridor Users and Stakeholders.
- 3**
L. Cemetery main gate.
Q. How many dogs can one person bring into the cemetery?
A. 4 maximum.
- 4**
L. East side of footpath near the junction of Tyrwhitt Road and Hilly Fields Crescent.
Q. What Bowls Club was established in 1906?
A. Francis Drake.
- 5**
L. Cranfield Road, south side, half way along.
Q. What church has Fr Thomas P John as vicar?
A. St Gregorios Indian Orthodox Church.
- 6**
L. St Peter’s Church.
Q. What are the names of the people staffing the Unlock workshop here?
A. Jacqueline and Mike.
- 7**
L. North-east corner with Friendly Street.
Q. What’s at 239 Lewisham Way?
A. Bank Buildings.
- 8**
L. South-east corner with Albyn Road (about half way along Albyn road on south side).
Q. What’s on the corner of Deloraine Street?
A. Allotments.
- 9**
L. Deptford High Street.
Q. Name five nationalities or ethnic groups represented along Deptford High Street.
A. *Five from:* African, Afro-Caribbean, Brazilian, Caribbean, Chinese, English, Japanese, Malaysian, Nigerian, Peruvian, Vietnamese.
- 10**
L. Prince Street, near east end, south side.
Q. What comes from Bremen in Germany to the Dog & Bell?
A. Beck’s (beer).

 L. Pepys Park near top (river side) of steps, south side of path.
 Q. How far is it along National Cycle Route 4 from Oxford to Dover?
 A. 225 miles (110 + 115).
- 12**
 L. Riverside walk, a little north of Pepys Park.
 Q. How many cannons can you see?
 A. *Accept 4 or 6. (Half a mark for 3.)
 (There are 3 together and 1 close, but also another 2 further along out of sight .)*

 L. Riverside walk, south of South Dock.
 Q. Why should this square remind you of the date of next year's Unlock Walk?
 A. St George's Square.
- 14**
 L. Rope Street, near Swing Bridge, south side of entrance to Greenland Dock.
 Q. What was the instrument housed in Tide Gauge House used for?
 A. Measuring the height of water in the river.
- 15**
 L. Inside Surrey Docks Farm.
 Q. What is the name of Surrey Docks Farm Café?
 A. Piccalilli Caff. *(Need both words, correctly spelled, for full mark.)*
- 16**
 L. Lady Dock Path running into Russia Walk crossing another cycle route.
 Q. From where were whale products imported?
 A. (Cape Farewell) Greenland.
- 17**
 L. Albion Road, west side.
 Q. Steps down and white tiles. Pedestrian access to what?
 A. Rotherhithe Tunnel.
- 18**
 L. Albion Road, west side, just north of St Olav's.
 Q. Another Scandinavian Church, with hostel accommodation. When was the Finnish Church foundation stone laid?
 A. 12th January, 1957.

 L. West side of Southwark Park.
 Q. What time will Moreton Terrace Gates be locked?
 A. 19.45 *(or 7.45 pm)*
- 20**
 L. Salmon Youth Centre.
 Q. (a) (Easy) What must users of the Centre do as well as keeping calm?
 (b) (More difficult) Who was the Centre's "Member of the Year 2013"?
 (c) (Even harder) What is his nickname?
