Locations, Questions and Answers (with Walk Day amendments)

1

L. ne corner, Durham Rd/Coombe Lane.

Q. What is Princess Alice's strap-line?

A. Caring when it matters.

L. w corner, Seaforth Ave/West Barnes Lane.

Q. What is the colour of the face of the lady at No. 2?

A. Purple. (Or similar eg lilac.)

3

L. Short post where walk route turns sharply near pools.

Q. What is the number on the post where the route turns sharply?

A. 4.

4a

L. Tree on s side of footpath near end of water (and not far from display panel below).

Q. (By post number 2, 50m north-west of 4b) It's not dead, it liveth. What is it?

A. Old oak tree. (Tree will do.) (Also accept "Old Stumpy" which is the local name.)

L. Display panel, n side of footpath, midway along water.

Q. (50m south-east of 4a) How many different kinds of birds might you see on or near the lake? (Male and female only count once.)?

A. 11

L. Shopping parade opp St James Ch, s side Martin Way, just e of Cannon Hill Lane.

Q. How might Truelove help you at the end of your life?

A. Undertakers. (Accept e.g. Directing your funeral & crafting your monument.)

L. n side Martin Way, se corner Mostyn Gardens.

Q. Where is it safe to take your scooter?

A. Poplar Community Scooter Park.

L. s side roundabout, between Morden Hall Road and Abbotsbury Road.

Q. When was Wheatlands established as a Furniture Centre?

A. 1936 (Do not accept More than 30 years, or similar, which relates to a Bed Store.)

L. Display board, n side of footpath at entrance to Morden Hall Park.

Q. What is the size of N.T. Morden Hall Park?

A. 125 acres.

L. At tramlink crossing, on n side.

Q. What organisation operates from Tyndale House in Deer Park Road?

A. Trinitarian Bible Society

L. Deen City Farm entrance gate.

Q. How much does it cost to keep the Deen City Farm running?

A. More than half a million pounds.

A. Small animal boarding. (Also accept a list of 9 specific features of the boarding provision.)

Q. How long does it take for one full turn of the mill wheel?
A. About half a minute. (Accept anything between 15 and 40 seconds.)
- 12**
L. Unlock Base Church.
Q. Where in the UK did work on Unlocking bible women start?
A. Woodhouse, Sheffield
- 13**
L. Nelson Gardens, se corner High Path/Morden Road.
Q. What did Isaac Smith do 100 years after Lord Nelson died?
A. Donated land from Merton Abbey Estate to Merton Council.

L. e side Merton Road, s of Ridley Road, opposite Griffiths Road.
Q. What might little ones do while having their hair cut at Shiny Stars?
A. Fly a plane or drive a car or jeep. (Accept Sky King, Mini-Cooper, Hummer.)

L. n side of The Broadway, near junction with Merton Road.
Q. Name one production on or coming at the Polka Theatre.
A. The theatre is closed for refurbishment, so the correct answer should be "None".
But accept Wind in the Willows or In the Winter Wood as the most recent productions.

L. YMCA, n side The Broadway.
Q. When was YMCA established in Wimbledon?
A. 1875
- 16b**
L. YMCA, n side The Broadway.
Q. Who opened the current building?
A. Her Majesty the Queen Mother.
- 17**
L. n side Kingston Road, just w of Russell Road.
Q. This shop indicates that many local people may not have a fixed address.
A. Mailboxes, etc. was the intended answer, but also accept B & B, a nearby shop.

L. On street signs in John Innes Conservation Area.
Q. This philanthropist established a Horticultural Institute as well as this Garden Suburb.
A. John Innes.

L. Wimbledon Chase School & Nursery, n side of pedestrianised extension to Henfield Rd.
Q. What is the age range for "wrap around care" at this school and nursery?
A. 3 - 12
- 20**
L. ne corner, Pepys Rd/Worple Rd.
Q. Are you sure this is a dentist?
A. ConfiDent.
