A. Accept any of: Pugilist, Boxer, English Champion.

L. Weavers Fields monument
Q. What award did Weavers Field win in 2017/2018?
A. Green Flag Award

L. St Matthews Row, n end, e side
Q. What famous broadcaster is depicted in this graffiti?
A. David Attenborough.

L. Commercial Street, w side
Q. In what year was Spitalfields Market Restored?
A. Accept either Queen Victoria's Jubilee or 1893

L. Fournier Street, n side
Q. What's next door to number eleven?
A. Eleven and a half

L. E end of Fournier Street, n side
Q. On this sundial the Latin means "We are but shadows". When was the Huguenot chapel (which later became a synagogue and is now a mosque) established?
A. 1743

A. Sheikh Mujibur Rahman
