

# Unlock Local Projects Development Worker Job Description



## **Vision: -**

This post forms part of a programme to develop Unlock under the central administration of the Unlock National Council, which is based in Sheffield. Formal Line Management will lie with the Chief Officer of Unlock. The Development Worker will be part of an Unlock Local Team. Unlock Development Workers are appointed to a limited geographical area and their duties are in relation to the area of their appointment.

## **Duties:-**

- To support small groups working with Unlock methodology.
- To help develop programmes of study for small groups
- To enable groups in such a way that they develop their own leadership
- To encourage an urban reading of the bible, which inspires people at individual, church, and community levels.
- To create and pursue opportunities to promote Unlock methodology.
- To seek out Christian Communities into which Unlock methodology can be introduced and develop working links with them.
- To establish and enable a supportive and creative network of those working independently with Unlock approaches.
- To establish the Unlock Local Team as a group of people who are committed to keeping the rumour of Unlock alive.

## **Requirements: -**

- That he/she carries out work using or representing Unlock's methods under the Unlock name or banner.
- That he/she is committed to working in collaboration with local churches and other organisations.
- That he/she is committed to working in teams.
- That he/she is committed to working towards creating new resources in Unlock's style. The copyright of materials prepared by the worker shall belong to Unlock, unless specifically authorized by the Council.
- That he/she is accountable to the Chief Officer and the National Council for reviewing work and the development of new work.
- That he/she will work in such a way as to enable local leadership.
- That he/she will seek to introduce Unlock methodology into new contexts.
